Call to order: 9:30 am

New Business

1. Spring Convention
 - Virtual
 - ~2 hours long (possibly 10 am to 12 pm)
 - March 8th
 - Need shirts
 - Either we can charge the attendees \$10 per person to pay for the guest speakers and/or raise money for next year's budget. If there is a fee, cap it to \$100 per school. However, if we want to make the convention free (due to it being virtual), Glenwood and Taylorville are willing to cover the expenses
 - There will be one form per school, excluding the Cenois district Eboard members
 - For the meets, we could pay a third party to oversee the meet and prevent people from causing unwanted problems or interruptions. Either use google meets or use Zoom, which might be a better option. With google, only the teachers can oversee the meet. On the other hand, Zoom might have a time limit. Ms. Field could reach out to Glenwood's tech team to see if they could help make it run more smoothly
 - Have a test run of the convention after a headcount is received
 - Zoom is the chosen means of attendance
2. T-shirts
 - No shirts ordered yet. Last year, Glenwood ordered them in the fall. This year, possibly repeat design, but change color to a powder blue
 - The Glenwood PR team could collaborate. Forms need to be sent out for shirts and spring convention attendance
 - Eboard will have separate forms for custom T-shirts (name and position on shirt)
3. Elections
 - Send out applications for those who wish to run for next year's Eboard. The elections/speeches will take place during the virtual spring convention
4. Service project
 - Neil has turned his school's project in, but few others, if any, have done the same
 - Most schools are strict about gatherings, so not many councils are able to participate in the clean-ups
 - Move due date from February to April (sometime before state convention).

5. Schools

- Auburn High School has considered joining, so they need to pay the fee to the IASC if they wish to attend the spring convention and/or run for office this year
- Check the IASC website for advisors' emails. Also, a list of active and inactive schools is available. Over 100 schools in the Cenais district, but few of them are active
